THE UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE (INSURANCE INDUSTRY SPECIAL SCHEME) (VARIATION AND AMENDMENT) ORDER (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1935, DATED 30TH OCTOBER, 1935, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER THE UNEMPLOYMENT ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1934 (24 AND 25 GEORGE V. CHAPTER 12).

### 1935. No. 139.

WHEREAS the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") by the Unemployment Insurance (Insurance Industry Special Scheme) Orders (Northern Ireland), 1921-1935, approved for the purposes of Section 18 of the Unemployment Insurance Act, 1920, a Special Scheme for the Insurance Industry and varied and amended the said Scheme, which Scheme, as so varied and amended, is hereinafter referred to as "the Scheme";

And whereas it is provided by Sub-Section (2) of Section 21 of the Unemployment Act (Northern Ireland), 1934, that for the purpose of securing in the case of a Special Scheme that like rates of benefit shall be payable to the persons to whom the Scheme applies as are for the time being payable under the enactments relating to Unemployment Insurance, and that the benefits under the Scheme shall otherwise be not less favourable than those for the time being provided by the general provisions of those enactments (but for no other purpose), the Ministry may, after consultation with the body charged with the administration of the Scheme, notwithstanding anything in section eighteen of the principal Act, by Order vary or amend the provisions of the Scheme ;

And whereas for the purposes mentioned in the said Sub-section (2) it is necessary further to vary and amend the provisions of the Scheme :

And whereas the Insurance Unemployment Board is the Body charged with the administration of the Scheme ;

Now, therefore, the Ministry, after consultation with the Insurance Unemployment Board, hereby makes the following Order :---

1. The provisions of the Scheme shall be varied and amended by substituting 3s. 0d. for 2s. 0d. in the second column of Part II of the Benefit Table contained in the Second Schedule thereto.

2. This Order shall come into operation on the 31st day of October, 1935.

**3.** This Order may be cited as the Unemployment Insurance (Insurance Industry Special Scheme) (Variation and Amendment)

#### VALUATION.

## Annual Revision.

REGULATIONS DATED THE 28TH DAY OF JANUARY, 1935, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER SECTION 15 OF THE VALUATION ACTS AMENDMENT ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1932.

#### 1935. No. 21.

The Ministry of Finance in exercise of the powers conferred upon the said Ministry by Section 15 of the Valuation Acts Amendment Act (Northern Ireland), 1932, hereby makes the following Regulations :---

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Annual Revision of Valuation Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1935.

(2) In these regulations the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them, that is to say :---

"The Act of 1852" and "the Act of 1854" mean, respectively, the Valuation (Ireland) Act, 1852, and the Valuation (Ireland) Act, 1854;

"The Adaptation Order of 1899" means the Local Government (Adaptation of Irish Enactments Order), 1899;

"Urban district" and "urban district council" include, respectively, a county borough or other borough and the council of any such borough, and "clerk" includes the town clerk of a borough;

"The Commissioner" means the Commissioner of Valuation :

Other expressions have the same meaning as in the Valuation Acts (Northern Ireland), 1852 to 1932,
