

REGULATIONS, DATED 2ND DECEMBER, 1935, MADE BY THE  
 MINISTRY OF EDUCATION, NORTHERN IRELAND, UNDER  
 SECTIONS 65, 69 AND 77 OF THE EDUCATION ACT (NORTHERN  
 IRELAND), 1923, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE MINISTRY  
 OF FINANCE, NORTHERN IRELAND, AND DULY LAID BEFORE  
 PARLIAMENT.

1. These Regulations may be cited as "The Regulations for  
 Technical Teachers, 1932, Amending Regulations, No. 3, 1935."

2. Regulation 4 (b) of the Regulations for Technical Teachers,  
 1932, (hereinafter called the Principal Regulations) is deleted  
 and the following is substituted therefor :

4.—(b) he has duly fulfilled the statutory conditions in  
 regard to the Oath or Declaration of Allegiance.

3. Persons appointed as principals, in addition to possessing  
 the academic qualifications necessary for certification, must be  
 suitable in other respects for the position.

4. That portion of regulation 16 of the Principal Regulations  
 which sets forth the scale of salary for Group J, (Principal of the  
 Municipal College of Technology) is hereby repealed and the  
 following substituted therefor :

GROUP J.

Principal of the Municipal College } £1,000 rising by annual in-  
 of Technology, Belfast. } crements of £50 to £1,250.

5. Regulation 19 of the Principal Regulations is hereby repealed  
 and the following substituted therefor :

19. For the purposes of Regulation 16 hereof the Depart-  
 ments of the Municipal College of Technology, Belfast, are  
 graded as follows :—

6. These Amending Regulations shall take and have effect as  
 from 1st August, 1935, and shall thenceforth be construed with  
 and as forming part of the Principal Regulations.
