THE PIG INDUSTRY COUNCIL (TERM OF OFFICE) ORDER (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1935, DATED 27TH FEBRUARY, 1935, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER SECTION FOUR OF THE AGRICULTURAL MARKETING (PIG INDUSTRY) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1934 (25 Geo. 5, Ch. 3).

Whereas by section four of the Agricultural Marketing (Pig Industry) Act (Northern Ireland), 1934 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") it is provided *inter alia* that the members of the body established under section four of the Act and called the Pig Industry Council for Northern Ireland (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") shall hold office for such term and subject to such conditions as the Minister of Agriculture may determine:

Now, therefore, I, The Right Honourable Sir Basil Stanlake Brooke, Bart., the Minister of Agriculture for Northern Ireland, hereby order and determine as follows:—

- 1. The members of the Council appointed by the Bacon Marketing Board and by the Pigs Marketing Board shall hold office until the 31st day of May, 1936, but shall be eligible for re-appointment.
- 2. This Order may be cited as the Pig Industry Council (Term of Office) Order (Northern Ireland), 1935.
