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RULES MADE BY THE UNEMPLOYMENT ASSISTANCE BOARD FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER SECTIONS 33 (1), 38 AND 46 (1) OF THE UNEMPLOYMENT ASSISTANCE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1934.

1935. No. 16.

The Unemployment Assistance Board for Northern Ireland by virtue of the powers conferred on it by Section 46 of the Unemployment Assistance Act (Northern Ireland), 1934, and of all other powers in that behalf hereby makes the following Rules :—

1. An application for a decision of the question whether a person is or is not a person to whom the Act applies or for the revision of such a decision shall be made on the prescribed form.

2. For the purpose of registering for employment as required by Section 33 (1) of the Act a person shall register as required by the Ministry for the purpose of the Labour Exchanges Act, 1909.

3. Subject to these Rules a person desiring to apply for an allowance or to renew an application for an allowance shall attend at an Employment Exchange or at such other place as may be specified by the Board and make an application on the

Registration for Employment.

prescribed form ; provided that the Board may permit a person to forward an application for an allowance through the post.

4. A person shall be treated as having made an application for an allowance on the date on which the form of application is received at the Employment Exchange or other specified place, or on such earlier date as appears to the Board reasonable.

5. A person shall, for the purpose of proving the matters specified in paragraphs (b) and (c) of sub-section (1) of Section 33 of the Act—

- (1) make and sign a statement for the purpose of a determination in his case, containing full information as to his circumstances and the circumstances of the household of which he is a member ;
- (2) if an Unemployment Book has been issued to him under the Unemployment Insurance Acts (Northern Ireland) lodge such book in the manner required by regulations under the said Acts on a claim for benefit :
- (3) (i) attend either at the Employment Exchange at which he made his application or at such other place as the Board may direct, on such occasions as he would be required to attend if he were claiming benefit (unless the Board in any individual case otherwise directs) and on such additional occasions as the Board with the assent of the Ministry may direct :
 - (ii) on each such attendance sign a register in accordance with directions given by the Board and furnish information in such manner as the Board may from time to time require regarding any work performed by him and any sums earned in respect thereof on any days in any week in respect of which an allowance may be payable ; provided that where he is not or would not be required to attend as aforesaid he may be required to furnish other evidence in proof of the matters specified in paragraphs (b) and (c) of sub-section (1) of Section 33 of the Act ;
- (4) produce such documents and furnish such further evidence in proof of the matters aforesaid as the Board or an Appeal Tribunal (as the case may be) may reasonably require :
- (5) comply with such directions as may be given by the Board with regard to reporting alterations in his circumstances and in the circumstances of members of the household of which he is a member.

6. The Board may, if it appears reasonable to do so, treat an applicant who fails to comply with the requirements of paragraph (3) of the preceding Rule or to register for employment in accordance with Rule 2 of these Rules as if he had duly complied or registered as the case may be.

Proof of the conditions for receipt of an allowance.

7. A person applying under Section 38 of the Act for permission to attend a training course shall register for employment in the manner prescribed in Rule 2 of these Rules and shall for the purpose of proving that he has no work attend at such place as the Board may specify and furnish such information as the Board may reasonably require.

8. In these Rules, save where the context otherwise requires— Inter-pretation.
- “ Act ” means the Unemployment Assistance Act (Northern Ireland), 1934.
- “ Benefit ” means unemployment benefit within the meaning of the Unemployment Insurance Acts (Northern Ireland).
- “ Board ” means the Unemployment Assistance Board for Northern Ireland.
- “ Ministry ” means Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland.
- “ Prescribed Form ” means that one of the forms set out in the Schedule to these Rules which is appropriate to the case or such form substantially to the same effect as may from time to time be approved by the Board.

9.—(1) These Rules may be cited as the Unemployment Assistance (Allowances) Rules (Northern Ireland), 1935.

(2) The Interpretation Act, 1921, applies to the interpretation of these Rules as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

These Rules shall come into force on the day after the day on which they are confirmed by the Minister of Labour for Northern Ireland.

RULES MADE BY THE UNEMPLOYMENT ASSISTANCE BOARD FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER SECTION 46 (1) OF AND THE FIFTH SCHEDULE TO THE UNEMPLOYMENT ASSISTANCE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1934.

1935. No. 9.

The Unemployment Assistance Board for Northern Ireland (hereinafter referred to as the "Board.") by virtue of the powers conferred on it by Section 46 of and the Fifth Schedule to the Unemployment Assistance Act (Northern Ireland), 1934, and of all other powers in that behalf hereby makes the following Rules :

1. Members of an Appeal Tribunal shall hold office for such periods as the Minister of Labour for Northern Ireland in the case of the Chairman or of a person appointed to act as Chairman, and the Board in the case of the other members, may prescribe at the time of their appointment.

Tenure of Office of members of Appeal Tribunals.

Provided that an appointment may be terminated at any time and shall be terminated if the person appointed (or a member of his household) makes an application for an allowance but without prejudice to his re-appointment if he and the members of his household cease to be applicants for an allowance.

2. Notwithstanding that the members of the Tribunal are not all present, any matter may, with the consent of the person concerned and of any Board of Guardians concerned and of the officer of the Board concerned, be proceeded with if two members of the Tribunal of whom the Chairman or acting Chairman shall be one are present.

Composition of Appeal Tribunals.
