WILD BIRDS PROTECTION.

Protected Birds.

ORDER MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER THE WILD BIRDS PROTECTION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1931.

1935. No. 46.

WHEREAS under Section 5 of the Wild Birds Protection Act (Northern Ireland), 1931, I, The Right Honourable Sir Richard Dawson Bates, Minister of Home Affairs, may by order alter the classification of any bird from one category under the said Act to another:

And whereas under Section 16 (1) (a) of the same Act, I am also empowered to prescribe from time to time by order the

variation or revocation of the time of special protection for any bird :

And whereas from time to time I have made orders altering the classification of certain birds and varying the time of special protection of such birds :

And whereas representations have been made to me-

1. That all orders heretofore made by me under Sections 5 and 16 (1) (a) of the Wild Birds Protection Act (Northern Ireland), 1931, should be consolidated;

2. That the classification of the herring gull and the heron should be altered.

And whereas Notice was duly given by me on the 15th February, 1935, in accordance with the provisions of Section 16 (6) of the Wild Birds Protection Act (Northern Ireland), 1931, of my intention to make such an order and the purport thereof:

And whereas objections to the making of such an order were duly received by me :

And whereas after consideration of the objections received I am still of opinion that such an order should be made :

Now, therefore, I, The Right Honourable Sir Richard Dawson Bates, Minister of Home Affairs hereby order and direct :

1. That all orders heretofore made by me under Sections 5 and 16 (1) (a) of the Wild Birds Protection Act (Northern Ireland), 1931, be revoked.

2. That such special protection as is afforded under the Wild Birds Protection Act (Northern Ireland), 1931, to the herring gull and the mute swan shall from the date hereof be revoked.

'3. That geese (all species save barnacle and brent) shall from the date hereof be transferred from Category 3 to Category 2.

4. That the coot, heron, and moorhen shall from the date hereof be transferred from Category 1 to Category 3.

5. That the time of special protection afforded to geese (all species save barnacle and brent) in Category 2 shall from the date hereof be from the 1st day of March to the 12th day of August in each year.
