The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section nine of the Milk and Milk Products Act (Northern Ireland), 1934, and of any other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations, that is to sav :---

1. Article 13 of the Milk (Grade B) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1934 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations") (a) shall have effect as if at the end thereof there were inserted the words " Provided that the Producer's licence fee shall be calculated at the rate of one fourth of a penny per gallon upon all milk sold or delivered during the period commencing on the 12th day of May, 1935, and ending on the 31st day of August, 1935, otherwise than to the holder of a Distributor's licence or to a creamery for the purpose of the extraction of cream for sale as such or for manufacture into butter."

2. Article 19 of the principal Regulations shall have effect as if at the end thereof there were inserted the words." Provided that the sum payable in respect of Producers' licence fees shall be calculated at the rate of one fourth of a penny for each gallon of milk purchased from a producer during the period commencing on the 12th day of May, 1935, and ending on the 31st day of August, 1935."
