THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION (INDUSTRIAL DISEASES)  
 (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER, 1935, DATED JUNE,  
 13TH, 1935, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR, EXTENDING  
 THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 44 OF THE WORKMEN'S  
 COMPENSATION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1927 (17 & 18  
 GEO. 5, C. 16).

In pursuance of the power conferred by Section 44, Sub-section  
 (3), of the Workmen's Compensation Act (Northern Ireland),  
 1927, the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland hereby makes  
 the following Order :—

1. Without prejudice to cases arising before the commencement  
 of this Order, the Workmen's Compensation (Industrial Diseases)  
 (Northern Ireland) Consolidation Order, 1929 (*a*) shall be amended

and take effect as if in place of the item numbered 28 in the first column of the Schedule annexed to that Order there were substituted—

“ 28. Inflammation, ulceration or malignant disease of the skin or subcutaneous tissues, or of the bones, or their sequelae, or anæmia of aplastic type, due to X-rays, radium, or other radio-active substance.”

2. This Order may be cited as the Workmen's Compensation (Industrial Diseases) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1935, and shall take effect on the 1st July, 1935.

### Medical Referees : Duties and Remuneration.

THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION (MEDICAL REFEREES) REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1935, DATED MARCH 13TH, 1935, MADE BY THE MINISTRIES OF LABOUR AND FINANCE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND AS TO THE DUTIES AND REMUNERATION OF MEDICAL REFEREES IN NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1927 (17 AND 18 GEO. 5. CH. 16).

1935. No. 40.

In pursuance of the powers conferred by the Workmen's Compensation Act (Northern Ireland), 1927, the Ministry of Labour and the Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland, hereby make the following regulations and direct that they shall come into force on the 1st day of July, 1935.

As from the said date the existing Regulations shall be revoked, namely :—

- (i) The regulations dated June 29, 1907, (a) as to the duties and fees of certifying and other surgeons, and as to references to, and remuneration and expenses of medical referees in Ireland (in so far as the said regulations apply to Northern Ireland) under Section 8 of the Workmen's Compensation Act, 1906, (b).
