DETERMINATION BY THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER SECTION 3 OF THE INTOXICATING LIQUOR ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1923, AS AMENDED BY THE INTOXICATING LIQUOR (FINANCE) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1925, OF THE RATES AT WHICH CHARGES ARE TO BE IMPOSED IN RESPECT OF LICENCES FOR THE SALE OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR BY RETAIL TO BE GRANTED OR RENEWED DURING THE YEAR ENDING 30TH SEPTEMBER, 1937.

In pursuance of sub-sections (3) (b) and (4) of Section 3 of the Intoxicating Liquor Act (Northern Ireland), 1923, as amended by the Intoxicating Liquor (Finance) Act (Northern Ireland), 1925, the Ministry of Finance hereby determines that the rates at which charges are to be levied in respect of all licences for the sale of intoxicating liquor by retail granted or renewed during the year ending 30th September, 1937, shall be thirteen shillings and sixpence for each pound sterling of the maximum rates of charge authorised by sub-section (1) of Section 1 of the Intoxicating Liquor (Finance) Act (Northern Ireland), 1925.

THE LABOURERS (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER, 1936, DATED 24TH APRIL, 1936, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS FOR NORTHERN IRELAND.

The Ministry of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland in pursuance of the provisions of the Labourers Acts (Northern Ireland), 1883 to 1935, and of all other powers in that behalf enabling the said Ministry hereby makes the following order:—

1. This order may be cited as "The Labourers (Northern Ireland) Order, 1936," and shall be construed as one with the Labourers (Ireland) Order, 1912, hereinafter referred to as "the principal order."
