THE UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE (ANOMALIES) (SEASONAL WORKERS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1936, DATED 10TH SEPTEMBER, 1936, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER THE UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE (ECONOMY) (NO. 3) ORDER (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1931, AS AMENDED BY SECTION 12 OF THE UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1934 (24 AND 25 GEO. V, CH. 12).

The Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, by virtue of the powers conferred on it by the Unemployment Insurance (Economy) (No. 3) Order (Northern Ireland), 1931, as extended and amended by Section 12 of the Unemployment Insurance Act (Northern Ireland), 1934, and Section 2 of the Unemployment Insurance (Amendment) Act (Northern Ireland), 1935, and of

all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Unemployment Insurance (Anomalies) (Seasonal Workers) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1936, and shall come into force on the 5th day of November, 1936.

(2) These Regulations and the Unemployment Insurance (Anomalies) (Seasonal Workers) Order (Northern Ireland), 1935 (which by virtue of sub-section (1) of Section 2 of the Unemployment Insurance (Amendment) Act (Northern Ireland), 1935, is to be deemed to be Regulations, and which is hereinafter referred to as “the Principal Regulations”), may be cited together as the Unemployment Insurance (Anomalies) (Seasonal Workers) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1935 and 1936.

(3) The Interpretation Act, 1921, applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. There shall be added after Article 6 of the Principal Regulations the following Article :—

“7. Nothing in these Regulations shall affect the right of any person to receive any agricultural benefit to which he is otherwise entitled.

The expression ‘agricultural benefit’ has the meaning assigned to it in the Unemployment Insurance (Agriculture) Act (Northern Ireland), 1936.”
