

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Contributory Pensions (Joint Committee) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1936.

2.—(1) In these Regulations—

“ The Act ” means the Widows', Orphans' and Old Age Contributory Pensions Act (Northern Ireland), 1925, as amended by any subsequent enactment ;

(2) The Interpretation Act, 1921, applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. The National Health Insurance Joint Committee alone shall exercise the power to make Regulations (relating to full-time instruction in a day school) under sub-section (2) of Section 1, paragraph (d) of Section 18, proviso (b) to sub-section (1) of Section 19 and Section 30 of the Act.

REGULATIONS, DATED 29TH DECEMBER, 1936, MADE BY THE
MINISTRY OF LABOUR UNDER SECTION 32 OF THE WIDOWS',
ORPHANS' AND OLD AGE CONTRIBUTORY PENSIONS ACT
(NORTHERN IRELAND), 1925.

The Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 32 of the Widows', Orphans' and Old Age Contributory Pensions Act (Northern Ireland), 1925, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf and with the consent of the National Health Insurance Joint Committee, hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Contributory Pensions (Joint Committee) Regulations (Northern Ireland) (No. 2), 1936.

(2) The Interpretation Act, 1921, applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The National Health Insurance Joint Committee alone shall exercise the powers of the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland to make regulations prescribing the period within which notice of any disease or disablement is to be given for the purposes of sub-section (1) of section 20 of the National Health Insurance and Contributory Pensions Act, 1935, as extended to Northern Ireland by the National Health Insurance and Contributory Pensions Act (Northern Ireland), 1935, and the National Health Insurance and Contributory Pensions (Enactments) Order (Northern Ireland), 1935.
