

ORDER DATED 11TH DAY OF JUNE, 1936, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER THE SUMMARY JURISDICTION AND CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1935.

In pursuance of the provisions of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Summary Jurisdiction and Criminal Justice Act (Northern Ireland), 1935, the Ministry of Home Affairs, after consultation with the County Court Judge and the Resident Magistrate concerned, hereby orders and directs that as and from the 1st day of July, 1936, the Petty Sessions at Lurgan shall be regularly held on the 1st and 3rd Tuesdays in each month at 10-30 a.m., and Juvenile Courts within the meaning of the Children's Act, 1908, shall be held in Lurgan on the 3rd Tuesday in each month at 10 a.m., and in Portadown on the 2nd Monday in each month at 10-30 a.m.

ORDER DATED 1ST DAY OF JANUARY, 1936, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER THE SUMMARY JURISDICTION AND CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1935.

In pursuance of the provisions of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Summary Jurisdiction and Criminal Justice Act (Northern Ireland), 1935, the Ministry of Home Affairs, after consultation with the County Court Judges and the Resident Magistrates concerned, hereby orders and directs as follows:—

1. As and from the 1st day of February, 1936.
 - (a) The townlands set forth in the First Schedule to this Order at present situate in the Petty Sessions District of Portaferry shall be added to the Petty Sessions District of Downpatrick;
 - (b) The townlands set forth in column 2 of the Second Schedule to this Order constituting the Petty Sessions Districts as set out in column 1 of the said Second Schedule shall be added to the Petty Sessions Districts set out in column 3 of the said Second Schedule;

(c) The Petty Sessions Districts named in column 1 of the Second Schedule shall be abolished :

2. As and from the date of this Order the times when Petty Sessions shall be regularly held in the districts set out in the first column of the Third Schedule to this Order shall be as set out in the second column of that Schedule opposite the names of each of such Petty Sessions Districts.
