### Milk Regulations : Grade A.

THE MILK (GRADE A) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1936, DATED 23RD DAY OF JUNE, 1936, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER SECTION NINE OF THE MILK AND MILK PRODUCTS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1934 (24 AND 25 GEO. V. CH. 16).

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section nine of the Milk and Milk Products Act (Northern Ireland), 1934, and of any other powers enabling it on that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations, that is to say:—

1. For paragraph (4) of Article 14 of the Milk (Grade A) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1934(a) (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Regulations") the following shall be substituted:—

"(4) Each bottle shall be closed with a suitable cap overlapping the lip of the bottle and so fastened as to form a complete seal, provided that where the bottle is of a capacity of less than half a pint, it may be closed with a tightly fitting disc. The cap or disc shall be green in colour and shall bear, embossed thereon or inscribed in white letters, the name and address of the producer or of the premises where the milk is produced, the day of production, and the words 'Grade A Milk,' the letter 'A' being at least half an inch in height, but no other words shall be embossed or inscribed upon the cap or disc. There may, in addition, be embossed upon the bottle, or inscribed thereon in green letters any of the particulars which under this regulation are required to be embossed or inscribed upon the cap or disc, provided that

where the milk is sold to a distributor for the purpose of resale by him, the name and address of such distributor may be substituted for the name and address of the producer or of the premises where the milk is produced, but no other name and address or no other words relating to the quality of the milk may be so embossed or inscribed.

Every churn to which milk is transferred in accordance with this regulation shall be sealed and labelled in a suitable manner with the name and address of the producer or of the premises where the milk is produced, the day of production (with the words 'morning' or 'evening' according to the time of milking), and the words 'Grade A.' The label shall be green in colour and the churn shall bear upon the neck the words 'Grade A' inscribed in green letters at least four inches in height, but no other words relating to the quality of the milk may be added.

Every carton to which milk is transferred under this regulation shall be sealed forthwith. The carton shall be white or cream in colour, and shall bear, in green letters, the name and address of the producer or of the premises where the milk is produced, the day of production and the words 'Grade A Milk,' but no other words relating to the quality of the milk may be added."

2. For Paragraph (3) of Article 20 of the principal Regulations there shall be substituted :—

" (3) Where the milk is bottled, each bottle shall be closed with a suitable cap overlapping the lip of the bottle and so fastened as to form a complete seal, provided that where the bottle is of a capacity of less than half a pint it may be closed with a tightly fitting disc. The cap or disc shall be green in colour, and shall bear, embossed thereon or inscribed in white letters, the name and address of the distributor or of the premises where the milk is bottled, the day of production and the words 'Grade A Milk,' the letter 'A' being at least half an inch in height, but no other words shall be embossed or inscribed upon the disc or cap. There may, in addition, be embossed upon the bottle or inscribed thereon in green letters any of the particulars which under this regulation are required to be embossed or inscribed upon the cap or disc, or where the milk is sold to another distributor for the purpose of resale by him, the name and address of such other distributor or the address of his premises, but no other name and address or no other words relating to the quality of the milk may be so embossed or inscribed.

Condition to be complied with by a distributor.

Every churn to which milk is transferred in accordance with this regulation shall be sealed and labelled in a suitable manner with the name and address of the distributor or of the premises where the milk is transferred to the churn, the

day of production (with the words 'morning' or 'evening' according to the time of milking), and the words 'Grade A.' The label shall be green in colour and the churn shall also bear upon the neck the words 'Grade A' inscribed in green letters at least four inches in height, but no other words relating to the quality of the milk.

Every carton to which milk is transferred under this regulation shall be sealed forthwith. The carton shall be white or cream in colour, and shall bear, in green letters, the name and address of the distributor or of the premises where the milk is transferred to the carton, the day of production and the words 'Grade A Milk,' but no other words relating to the quality of the milk may be added."

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Milk (Grade A) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1936, and these Regulations, the principal Regulations, and the Milk (Grade A) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1935(b), shall be construed together and may be cited as the Milk (Grade A) (Amended) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1936.
