Milk Regulations: Grade C.

THE MILK (GRADE C) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1936, DATED 23RD DAY OF JUNE, 1936, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER SECTION NINE OF THE MILK AND MILK PRODUCTS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1934 (24 AND 25 GEO V., CH. 16).

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section nine of the Milk and Milk Products Act (Northern Ireland), 1934, and of any other powers enabling it on that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations, that is to say:—

1. For paragraph (2) of Article 10 of the Milk (Grade C) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1934(a), (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Regulations) the following shall be substituted:—

Condition to be complied with by a producer,

- "(2) Where bottles are used for the delivery of milk they shall be sterilised for that purpose on the premises by steam. Each bottle shall be closed with a suitable tightly fitting disc or cap. The disc or cap shall be red in colour, and shall, subject to the provisions of these Regulations, bear, embossed thereon or inscribed in white letters, the name and address of the producer or of the premises where the milk is produced, the day of production, and the words 'Grade C Milk,' the letter C' being at least half an inch in height, but subject as aforesaid no other words shall be embossed or inscribed upon the disc or cap. There may, in addition, be embossed upon the bottle, or inscribed thereon in red letters any of the particulars which under this regulation are required to be embossed or inscribed upon the disc or cap, provided that where the milk is sold to a distributor for the purpose of resale by him, the name and address of such distributor may be substituted for the name and address of the producer or of the premises where the milk is produced, but no other name and address or no other words relating to the quality of the milk may be so embossed or inscribed."
- 2. For Paragraph (2) of Article 15 of the principal Regulations there shall be substituted:—
 - "(2) Where bottles other than bottles to which the milk has been transferred on the premises at which the milk was produced are used for the delivery of milk, they shall be sterilised by steam on the premises of the distributor. Each

Condition to be com plied with by a distributor. such bottle shall be closed with a suitable tightly fitting disc The disc or cap shall be red in colour and shall. subject to the provisions of these Regulations, bear embossed thereon or inscribed in white letters the name and address of the distributor by whom, or of the premises on which the milk is bottled, the day of production and the words 'Grade C Milk,' the letter 'C' being at least half an inch in height. but subject as aforesaid no other words shall be embossed or inscribed upon the disc or cap. There may, in addition, be embossed upon the bottle or inscribed thereon in red letters any of the particulars which under this regulation are required to be embossed or inscribed upon the disc or cap, provided that where the milk is sold to another distributor for the purpose of resale by him the name and address of such other distributor may be substituted for the name and address of the distributor by whom, or of the premises on which, the milk is bottled, but no other name and address or no other words relating to the quality of the milk, may be so embossed or inscribed."

3. These Regulations may be cited as the Milk (Grade C) (Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1936, and these Regulations, the principal Regulations, the Milk (Grade C) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1935(b), and the Amending Regulations shall be construed together and may be cited as the Milk (Grade C) (Amended) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1936.
