

Notification of Incapacity.

REGULATIONS, DATED NOVEMBER 5, 1937, MADE BY THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE JOINT COMMITTEE UNDER SECTIONS 6 AND 10 (1) OF THE WIDOWS', ORPHANS' AND OLD AGE CONTRIBUTORY PENSIONS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1936.

The National Health Insurance Joint Committee in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 and sub-section (1) of section 10 of the Widows', Orphans' and Old Age Contributory Pensions Act (Northern Ireland), 1936, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Regulations :—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Contributory Pensions (Notification of Incapacity) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1937.

(2) The Interpretation Act, 1921, applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

2. The prescribed period within which notice is required to be given of any disease or disablement for the purposes of section 6 and sub-section (1) of section 10 of the Widows', Orphans' and Old Age Contributory Pensions Act (Northern Ireland), 1936, shall be the period ending on a date twelve months after the date on which the free insurance period specified in that section or sub-section expired :

Provided that the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, if satisfied that there is in any particular case reasonable ground for so doing, may extend the period by a further period not exceeding six months.

3. The Contributory Pensions (Notification of Incapacity) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1936 are hereby revoked, but without prejudice to anything duly done or suffered, or to any right, privilege, obligation or liability acquired accrued or incurred thereunder.
