

THE PIGS MARKETING (NORTHERN IRELAND) (SPECIAL LEVY) (NO. 3) AMENDMENT ORDER, 1937, DATED 30TH NOVEMBER, 1937, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION 7 (3) OF THE AGRICULTURAL MARKETING ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1933.

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by sub-section (3) of Section Seven of the Agricultural Marketing Act (Northern Ireland), 1933, and of every other power enabling it in that behalf orders, and it is hereby ordered as follows :—

Amendment of Article 1 of the Pigs Marketing (Northern Ireland) (Special Levy) (No. 3) Order, 1937.

1. Article 1 of the Pigs Marketing (Northern Ireland) (Special Levy) (No. 3) Order, 1937, shall be read and have effect as if the following were substituted therefor :—

The Board shall, during the period 15th November, 1937, to 30th November, 1937, inclusive, for the purpose of meeting the said uncovered portion of the total loss impose a special levy of two shillings per pig upon all producers in the case of all sales of pigs by them to a curer or to the Board.

2. This Order may be cited as the Pigs Marketing (Northern Ireland) (Special Levy) (No. 3) Amendment Order, 1937, and shall come into force on the 30th day of November, 1937.
