REGULATIONS, DATED 13TH DECEMBER, 1937, MADE BY THE
MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER SECTION NINE OF THE
MILK AND MILK PRODUCTS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND),
1934.

1937. No. 131.

The Ministry of Agriculture in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Section Nine of the Milk and Milk Products Act (Northern Ireland), 1934, and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations, that is to say:—

Short Title.

1. These Regulations shall be known as “The Milk (Equalisation Payments) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1937, No. 2.”

Equalisation Payments.

2.—(a) The equalisation payment to be made in respect of all milk produced in Northern Ireland and delivered during the period beginning on the 10th day of November, 1937, and ending on the 31st day of March, 1938, to a creamery and used for the purpose of the extraction of cream for sale as such or for manufacture into butter shall be of such sum as will raise the average price paid by all creameries for such milk to six pence halfpenny per gallon.

(b) The equalisation payment to be made in respect of all milk produced in Northern Ireland and delivered during the period beginning on the 1st day of April, 1938, and ending on the 30th day of September, 1938, to a creamery and used for the purpose of the extraction of cream for sale as such or for manufacture into butter shall be of such sum as will raise the average price paid by all creameries for such milk to five pence per gallon.

THE JOINT MILK COUNCIL (ELECTION OF MEMBERS BY DISTRIBUTORS) REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1937, DATED THE 29TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1937, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER SECTION NINE OF THE MILK AND MILK PRODUCTS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1934 (24 AND 25 GEO. V, CH. 16).

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section Nine of the Milk and Milk Products Act (Northern Ireland), 1934, and of every other power enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations, that is to say:—

PART I.

Short Title and Interpretation.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Joint Milk Council (Election of Members by Distributors) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1937.

2.—(1) In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires—

“The Ministry” means the Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland;

“The Act” means the Milk and Milk Products Act (Northern Ireland), 1934;

“The Joint Milk Council” means the Joint Milk Council for Northern Ireland.

(2) The Interpretation Act, 1889 (a), as applied to Northern Ireland by the Interpretation Act, 1921(b), shall apply for the purpose of the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies for the purpose of the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Repeal.

3. The Joint Milk Council (Election of Members by Distributors) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1935(a) are hereby repealed.
