Acquisition of Undertakings. Extension of Period.

Order of the Ministry of Home Affairs, dated 1st June, 1937, extending the period within which the Northern Ireland Road Transport Board may acquire road motor undertakings.

THE LOCAL CARRIERS REGULATIONS, 1937, DATED 14TH MAY, 1937.

1937. No. 41.

Whereas the Ministry of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland in exercise of the powers vested in the Ministry by Section 16 of the Road and Railway Transport Act (Northern Ireland), 1935, (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") made regulations with respect to the licensing of Local Carriers:

And whereas it is expedient to amend the said regulations in manner hereinafter appearing:

Now, therefore, the Ministry of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland in exercise of the powers vested in the Ministry by the Act, hereby makes the following regulations:—

- 1. The regulations may be cited as the Local Carriers Regulations, 1937, and shall be construed as one with the Local Carriers Regulations, 1935, (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Regulations").
- 2. The following paragraph shall be added after paragraph (b) of Article 5 of the principal Regulations:—
 - "(c) If the Licensee fails to keep and, on being required by an officer appointed by the Ministry, fails to produce wages sheets or other records of time worked by and wages paid to persons employed by him."
