

Short Title and Commencement.

Pig Industry : Grading.

THE PIGS MARKETING (GRADING) (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER, 1936, (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1937, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER SECTION 7 (1) OF THE AGRICULTURAL MARKETING (PIG INDUSTRY) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1934 (25 GEO. V, CH. 3).

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 7 (1) of the Agricultural Marketing (Pig Industry) Act (Northern Ireland), 1934, and of every other power enabling it in that behalf orders and it is hereby ordered as follows :—

*Amendment of First Schedule of the Pigs Marketing
(Grading) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1936.*

1. (A) Part I of the First Schedule to the Pigs Marketing (Grading) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1936 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order) shall be read and have effect as if the following were substituted therefor :—

(B) Paragraph (a) relating to ungraded pigs in the First Schedule to the principal Order shall be read and have effect as if the following were substituted therefor :—

Ungraded Pigs.

(a) All pig carcasses which weigh less than 1 cwt. 0 qrs. 21 lb. or more than 2 cwt. 0 qrs. 14 lb.

Short Title.

2. This Order may be cited as the Pigs Marketing (Grading) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1936 (Amendment) Order, 1937.

Commencement.

3. This Order shall come into operation on the date hereof.
