## 1937. No. 71.

The Ministry of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland in exercise of the powers vested in it by the Local Government Acts (Northern Ireland), 1898 to 1937, hereby orders and directs that not-withstanding anything in any Order to the contrary the times for the proceedings at the elections of Councillors (or Aldermen or Councillors) in County Boroughs and Boroughs and of Urban District Councillors shall in the year 1937 be as set out in the Table in the Schedule hereto.

This Order may be cited as the Local Government (Elections) Order, 1937.
