ORDER DATED 23RD OCTOBER 1937 MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER THE SUMMARY JURISDICTION AND CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACT (N.I.) 1935.

1937. No. 99.

In pursuance of the provisions of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Summary Jurisdiction and Criminal Justice Act (Northern Ireland) 1935 the Ministry of Home Affairs after consultation with the County Court Judge and the Resident Magistrate concerned, hereby orders and directs as follows :—

As and from the 1st day of December, 1937,

1. The townlands set forth in the First Schedule to this Order at present situate in the Petty Sessions district of Hillsborough shall be added to the Petty Sessions district of Ballynahinch.

2. The times when Petty Sessions shall be regularly held in the districts set out in the first column of the Second Schedule to this Order shall be as set out in the second column of that Schedule opposite the names of each of such Petty Sessions Districts.
