Revocation of Order prohibiting the bringing of animals into a Port in Northern Ireland from the Channel Islands.

1.—The Foreign Animals (Northern Ireland) Order of 1938 is hereby revoked from and after the date of this Order.

Short Title.

2.—This Order may be cited as the Foreign Animals (Northern Ireland) (No. 2) Order of 1938.

Diseases of Animals: Foreign Hay and Straw.

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in it under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1935, as amended and adapted by any subsequent enactments and of every other power enabling it in that behalf orders and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

Exceptions withdrawn.

1.—The Foreign Hay and Straw (Ireland) Order of 1912 shall be read and have effect as if in its application to Northern Ireland paragraphs (a) and (b) of article 2 (Exception) were omitted therefrom.

Revocations.

2.—The Foreign Hay and Straw (Ireland) Order of 1912 Amendment (Northern Ireland) Order, 1925, is hereby revoked as on and from the commencement of this Order.
