

ORDER, DATED 11TH NOVEMBER, 1938, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER THE SUMMARY JURISDICTION AND CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1935.

In pursuance of the provisions of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Summary Jurisdiction and Criminal Justice Act (Northern Ireland), 1935, the Ministry of Home Affairs, after consultation with the County Court Judge and the Resident Magistrate concerned, hereby orders and directs as follows :—

As and from the 1st day of December, 1938, the time when Petty Sessions shall be regularly held in the district set out in the first column of the Schedule to this Order shall be as set out in the second column of that Schedule opposite the name of the Petty Sessions district.
