be expected to be payable from the Fund during the ensuing sirmonths, and after consultation with the Trustees, suspends the payment by owners of animals exported to Great Britain from Northern Ireland of the charges required by the Acts for a further period as on and from the date hereof until the 1st of November, 1939.

Short Title.

2. This Order may be cited as the Exported Animals (Compensation) Acts (Northern Ireland), 1928 to 1938 (Suspension of Charges) Order, 1938.

Diseases of Animals: Foreign Animals.

ORDER DATED 21ST DAY OF JANUARY, 1938, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER THE DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACTS, 1894 TO 1935.

1938. No. 3.

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in it under the Diseases of Animals Act, 1894, as amended and adapted by any subsequent enactments and by every other power enabling it in that behalf, orders and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

Prohibition on the Bringing of Animals into a Port in Northern Ireland from the Channel Islands.

1. The Foreign Animals (Northern Ireland Order of 1928 shall be read and have effect as if the Channel Islands were excluded from the Schedule to that Order.

Short Title.

2. This Order may be cited as the Foreign Animals (Northern Ireland) Order of 1938.

Commencement.

3. This Order shall come into operation as from the date thereof.
