ORDER, DATED 27TH NOVEMBER, 1939, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR UNDER THE FACTORIES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1938.

1939. No. 181.

The Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the Factories Act (Northern Ireland), 1938, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1.—This Order may be cited as the Factories (Forms and Particulars) (No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland), 1939.

2.—In this Order the expression “the Act” means the Factories Act (Northern Ireland), 1938.

3.—Paragraph 22 of the Factories (Forms and Particulars) Order (Northern Ireland), 1939*, shall have effect so far as it relates to steam boilers which are steam tube ovens or steam tube hot plates

as if for the form N.I.55 set out in the Schedule to that Order there was substituted the form N.I.62 set out in the Schedule to this Order. Form N.I. 62

ORDER, DATED 10TH DAY OF MAY, 1939, MADE BY THE
MINISTRY OF LABOUR UNDER SECTION 34 (2) OF THE FACTORIES
ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1938.

1939. No. 65.

1.—In pursuance of sub-section (2) of Section 34 of the Factories Act (Northern Ireland), 1938, and all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland hereby prescribes that the record required by that sub-section to be kept with respect to examinations of water-sealed gasholders shall contain the following particulars:—

- (i) Name of occupier of factory;
- (ii) Address of factory;
- (iii) Distinguishing number or letter and type of Gasholder;
- (iv) (a) Number of lifts,
(b) Maximum capacity in cubic feet,
(c) Pressure thrown by holder when full of gas;
