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## TRADE BOARDS.

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### Appointment of Members.

REGULATIONS, DATED THE 22ND DECEMBER, 1939, AMENDING REGULATIONS MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR UNDER SECTION 17 OF THE TRADE BOARDS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1923, (13 AND 14 GEO. 5, CH. 32), WITH RESPECT TO THE CONSTITUTION, PROCEEDINGS AND MEETINGS OF TRADE BOARDS.

The Ministry of Labour (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry"), in pursuance of powers conferred by the Trade Boards Act (Northern Ireland), 1923, as amended by Section 2 of the Trade Boards Act (Northern Ireland), 1939, and of every other power the Ministry hereunto enabling, hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1. The following Regulation shall be substituted for Regulation 2 (a) of each of the Regulations specified in the Schedule :—

" 2.—(a) Either one appointed member, or three appointed members, as the Ministry may think fit ; "

2. The following Regulation shall be substituted for Regulation 3 of each of the Regulations specified in the Schedule :—

" 3.—Appointed members shall be independent persons appointed by the Ministry. The Chairman of the Trade Board shall be the appointed member designated by the Ministry to act as Chairman. "

3. The following Regulation shall be substituted for Regulation 15 of each of the Regulations specified in the Schedule :—

“15.—The appointed member (or members) shall vote only when the other votes are equally divided. The vote of the appointed member or the majority vote of the appointed members, as the case may be, shall then be in the nature of a casting vote.”

4. The Interpretation Act, 1921, applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.
