REGULATIONS, DATED 3RD AUGUST, 1940, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER SECTIONS 73, 75, 76 AND 77 OF THE EDUCATION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1923, AS AMENDED BY THE EDUCATION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1930, WITH THE APPROVAL OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

In accordance with the provisions of Sections 73, 75, 76 and 77 of the Education Act (Northern Ireland), 1923 (hereinafter called "the Act"), as amended by the Education Act (Northern Ireland), 1930, the Ministry of Education for Northern Ireland (hereinafter called "the Ministry"), with the approval of the Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland, hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1.—These regulations may be cited as "The Parliamentary Grant (Education Authorities) Regulations, 1941-42."

2.—The regulations for the payment of the Parliamentary Grant in aid of expenses of Education Authorities in respect of the financial year ending 31st March, 1942, shall be regulations 2 to 8 inclusive of those made in respect of the financial year ending 31st March, 1941 (Statutory Rules and Orders of Northern Ireland, 1939, No. 146), subject to the following amendments:—
