

“ University Authority ” means the Chancellor, the Pro-Chancellors, the President and Vice-Chancellor, the Senate, the Academic Council, the General Board of Studies, the Faculties and Convocation ;

“ University fund or property ” includes any property or endowment, whether or not being trust property, which is held by or on behalf of the University for any purpose within or connected with the University and whether the income is administered by the University or by any other body ;

“ War Service ” means service during the period of the present emergency in any of the naval, military or air forces of the Crown, or any service during that period which in the opinion of the Minister of Education for Northern Ireland may properly be treated for the purposes of this Order in the same manner as service in those forces.

Short title.

7.—This Order may be cited as the Queen’s University of Belfast (Temporary Provisions) Order, 1940.

Acquisition of Undertakings: Extension of Period.

1940. No. 52.

I, THE RIGHT HONOURABLE SIR RICHARD DAWSON BATES, BT., MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS FOR NORTHERN IRELAND, in pursuance of the powers vested in me by Section 5 of the Road and Railway Transport Act (Northern Ireland), 1935, as amended by Section 3 of the Road Transport Act (Northern Ireland), 1938, and of all other powers in that behalf thereunto enabling me, but without prejudice to any further exercise of such powers, hereby order and direct that the period within which the Northern Ireland Road Transport Board may acquire every road motor undertaking operated for hire or reward in Northern Ireland, including the passenger and freight road transport services of any railway company operating in Northern Ireland, shall be extended to the 31st day of December, 1940.

Petty Sessions: Districts and Times.

ORDER, DATED 20TH SEPTEMBER, 1940, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF
HOME AFFAIRS UNDER THE SUMMARY JURISDICTION AND
CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1935.

In pursuance of the provisions of sub-section (1) of Section 10
of the Summary Jurisdiction and Criminal Justice Act (Northern
Ireland), 1935, the Ministry of Home Affairs, after consultation
with the County Court Judge and the Resident Magistrate
concerned, hereby orders and directs, as follows:—

As and from the 8th day of October, 1940,

1.—The Townlands set forth in column 2 of the Schedule to this
Order constituting the Petty Sessions District as set out in
column 1 of the said Schedule shall be added to the Petty Sessions
Districts set out in column 3 of the said Schedule.

2.—The Petty Sessions District named in column 1 of the
Schedule shall be abolished.
