TO THE COUNCIL OF EACH COUNTY BOROUGH IN NORTHERN IRELAND AND

TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Whereas the Ministry of Home Affairs, in exercse of the powers vested in it by Section 18 of the Local Government Act (Northern Ireland), 1934, did by Order of the 25th day of September, 1935, prescribe qualifications with respect to the appointment of Town Clerks and Deputy Town Clerks of County Boroughs in Northern Ireland;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the said Order of the 25th day of September, 1935, should be amended:

Now, THEREFORE, the Ministry of Home Affairs, in exercise of the powers vested in it by Section 18 of the Local Government Act (Northern Ireland), 1934, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling the Ministry, hereby orders as follows, that is to say:—

- 1.—Paragraph (i) of sub-article (a) of Article 1 of The County Borough Councils (Town Clerks and Deputy Town Clerks Qualifications) Order, 1935, shall have effect as if there were added at the end of that paragraph the words "(e) chartered secretary."
- 2.—This Order may be cited as "The County Borough Councils (Town Clerks and Deputy Town Clerks Qualifications) Order (Northern Ireland), 1940," and shall be read and construed as one with "The County Borough Councils (Town Clerks and Deputy Town Clerks Qualifications) Order, 1935."
