TO THE GUARDIANS OF THE POOR OF EACH POOR LAW UNION IN NORTHERN IRELAND:

To the Council of each Rulal District in Northern Ireland;

TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Whereas the Ministry of Home Affairs, in exercise of the powers vested in it by Section 18 of the Local Government Act (Northern Ireland), 1934, did by Order of the 4th day of June, 1935, prescribe qualifications with respect to the appointments of Clerks and Assistant Clerks of Poor Law Unions and Rural District Councils in Northern Ireland;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the said Order of the 4th day of June, 1935, should be amended:

Now, THEREFORE, the Ministry of Home Affairs, in exercise of the powers vested in it by Section 18 of the Local Government Act (Northern Ireland), 1934, and of every other power in that behalf thereunto enabling the Ministry, hereby orders as follows, that is to say:—

- 1.—Paragraph (i) of sub-article (a) of Article 1 of The Unions and Rural District Councils (Officers Qualifications) Order, 1935, shall have effect as if there were added at the end of that paragraph the words "or a Chartered Secretary."
- 2.—This Order may be cited as "The Unions and Rural District Councils (Officers Qualifications) Order (Northern Ireland), 1940," and shall be read and construed as one with "The Unions and Rural District Councils (Officers Qualifications) Order, 1935."
