ORDER, DATED THE 2ND DAY OF AUGUST, 1940, MADE BY THE
MINISTRY OF PUBLIC SECURITY UNDER SECTION 1 OF THE CIVIL
DEFENCE ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1939.

WHEREAS by Section 1 of the Civil Defence Act (Northern Ireland), 1939 (hereinafter in this Order referred to as "the Act"), it is provided that Part I of the Act shall apply only in relation to areas specified in that behalf in an Order made by the Ministry of Home Affairs;

AND WHEREAS the Ministry of Home Affairs made an Order entitled the Civil Defence (Specified Areas) Order (Northern Ireland), 1939;

AND WHEREAS the Governor of Northern Ireland has, in pursuance of powers vested in him by sub-section (3) of section 1 of the Ministries Act (Northern Ireland), 1940, made an Order transferring to the Ministry of Public Security the powers and duties of the Ministry of Home Affairs under the Civil Defence Acts (Northern Ireland), 1938 and 1939;

Now, THEREFORE, the Ministry of Public Security, in pursuance of all the powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1.—The Civil Defence (Specified Areas) Order (Northern Ireland), 1939, is hereby revoked, but without prejudice to anything duly done or suffered, or to any right, privilege, obligation, or liability acquired, accrued or incurred thereunder.

2.—Part I of the Act shall apply to the whole of Northern Ireland.

3.—This Order may be cited as the Civil Defence (Specified Areas) Order (Northern Ireland), 1940.

Storage and Loan of Equipment.

REGULATIONS, DATED 21ST DECEMBER, 1940, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF PUBLIC SECURITY WITH THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER SECTION 10 OF THE AIR-RAID PRECAUTIONS ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1938.

Whereas by section ten of the Air-Raid Precautions Act (Northern Ireland), 1938, it is provided that the Ministry of Home Affairs may, with the concurrence of the Ministry of Finance, make regulations for the purposes of the said Act :

And Whereas by virtue of the Ministries Act (Northern Ireland), 1940, and the Orders made thereunder, the functions exercisable by the Ministry of Home Affairs under the Civil Defence Acts (Northern Ireland), 1938 and 1939, were transferred to the Ministry of Public Security :

Now, Therefore, the Ministry of Public Security (hereinafter referred to as " the Ministry "), by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by the Civil Defence Acts (Northern Ireland), 1938 and 1939, and of all other powers in this behalf thereunto enabling the Ministry, with the concurrence of the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following regulations, that is to say :—

1.—These Regulations shall apply to equipment acquired by the Ministry under the Air-Raid Precautions Act (Northern Ireland), 1938, and furnished free of charge by the said Ministry to a local authority but shall not apply to equipment to which the Air-Raid Precautions (Loan of Fire Appliances) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1939, apply.

2.—The equipment is furnished to the local authority for the purpose of enabling the local authority to make provision—

(a) for the instruction of members of the public as to air-raid precautions and for their protection in the event of hostile attack from the air ;

(b) for the protection of property in that event ; and
