Order, dated July 14th, 1941, made by the Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland under the Feeding Stufes (Control) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1941.

## 1941. No. 137.

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland in pursuance of Article 2 of the Feeding Stuffs (Control) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1941 (a), hereby orders as follows:—

1.—No person shall export from Northern Ireland any oat products or by-products containing more than twenty-five per cent. of fibre:

Provided that this Order shall not apply to oat husks or shudes sold as such.

- 2.—This Order shall come into force on the 14th day of July, 1941.
- 3.—This Order may be cited as the Feeding Stuffs (Control) (Oat By-products) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1941.
