**TUBERCULOSIS.****Procedure of Committees.**

ORDER, DATED 29TH SEPTEMBER, 1941, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS UNDER THE TUBERCULOSIS PREVENTION (IRELAND) ACT, 1908.

1941. No. 168.

WHEREAS the Local Government Board for Ireland, in pursuance of the provisions of Section 5 of the Tuberculosis Prevention (Ireland) Act, 1908, made Regulations entitled the Tuberculosis (Procedure of Committees) Order, 1913 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") :

AND WHEREAS the principal Order was amended by the Tuberculosis (Procedure of Committees) Order, 1933 :

AND WHEREAS it appears expedient that the principal Order should be further amended in manner hereinafter appearing :

NOW, THEREFORE, the Ministry of Home Affairs by virtue of the powers vested in the Ministry by the Tuberculosis Prevention (Ireland) Act, 1908, and of all other powers in this behalf enabling the Ministry hereby orders and directs as follows :—

1.—The principal Order shall have effect as though the following paragraph was substituted for paragraph (3) of article three thereof :—

“(3) The Annual Meeting shall be held in the year in which the triennial appointment of the committee is made, not less than seven days and not more than twenty-eight days next after the appointment has been completed, and in every other year within the corresponding time from the anniversary of the date of appointment.”

2.—The Tuberculosis (Procedure of Committees) Order, 1933, is hereby revoked.

3.—This Order may be cited as the Tuberculosis (Procedure of Committees) Order, 1941, and shall be construed as one with the principal Order.

### Appeal Tribunals.

REGULATIONS, DATED 12TH DECEMBER, 1941, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR UNDER THE UNEMPLOYMENT ASSISTANCE (EMERGENCY POWERS) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1939.

1941. No. 211.

The Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, by virtue of the powers conferred on it by the Unemployment Assistance (Emergency Powers) Act (Northern Ireland), 1939, and of all powers in that behalf, hereby, with the approval of the Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland, makes the following Regulations :—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Unemployment Assistance (Appeal Tribunals) (Revocation) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1941, and shall come into force on the date hereof.

(2) The Interpretation Act, 1921, applies to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.
