- (e) Upper Lough Erne.
- (f) Lower Lough Erne.
- (g) Such portions of the River Erne as are situated in Northern Ireland.

SPECIFIED CLASSES OF PERSONS.

Registration.

THE SPECIFIED CLASSES OF PERSONS (REGISTRATION) (No. 2) (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER, 1941, DATED JANUARY 15, 1941, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER REGULATION 58A OF THE DEFENCE (GENERAL) REGULATIONS, 1939.

1941. No. 21.

The Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry"), by virtue of the powers conferred upon it by Regulation 58A of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939 (a), hereby makes the following Order.

1.—This Order may be cited as the Specified Classes of Persons (Registration) (No. 2) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1941, and shall come into force on the date hereof.

2.—Every person to whom this Order applies shall register particulars about himself in the form set out in the First Schedule hereto or in such other form approved by the Ministry substantially to the like effect.

3.—(1) Every person to whom this Order applies—

(a) shall make application either in writing to the Ministry of Labour, Stormont, Belfast, or in person or writing to any Employment Exchange, not later than the tenth day after the coming into force of this Order, for a form for the purpose of the registration aforesaid; and

(b) shall complete the form sent to him and deliver it to the nearest Employment Exchange of the Ministry within five

days of its receipt by him. For this purpose the form shall be deemed to have been received by such person on the third day after its despatch to him, and to have been duly delivered by him if it is posted on the last of the five days.

(2) If at any time while a person is registered under the provisions of this Order a change occurs in his name or address or in the place where he is employed or carries on his occupation he shall forthwith notify the change to the nearest Employment Exchange of the Ministry.

4.—(1) This Order applies to the class of persons described in the Second Schedule hereto, provided that this Order shall not apply to any person who is on any of the above-mentioned dates already registered at an Employment Exchange of the Ministry.

(2) This Order applies to any member of the Local Defence Volunteer Section of the Ulster Special Constabulary who is in the said class, but does not apply to any person while he is actually serving with the armed forces of the Crown.
