

at the date of the reduction, the teacher had reached or passed the age of 60, the rate of salary at which he was being paid before the reduction may be restored to him with effect from 1st April, 1940.

6.—Article 3 of the Public Elementary Schools Regulations, Amending Regulations, No. 9 (Statutory Rules and Orders of Northern Ireland, 1938, No. 125) is hereby amended by the substitution of the words “from 30th June, 1938, until further notice” for the words “for the period from 30th June, 1938, to 30th June, 1941.”

7.—These regulations shall be construed with and as forming part of the Principal Regulations.

REGULATIONS, DATED 3RD MARCH, 1941, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE EDUCATION ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1923 TO 1940, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

1941. No. 72.

1.—These regulations may be cited as the Public Elementary Schools (Evacuated Children) Regulations, 1940, Amending Regulations, No. 1, 1941.

2.—The Public Elementary Schools (Evacuated Children) Regulations, 1940 (Statutory Rules and Orders of Northern Ireland, 1940, No. 15), are hereby amended as follows :

3.—Article 6 of the said Regulations is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following sub-section :

6.—(d) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-sections (a) and (b) of this article, a teacher to whom either of these sub-sections relates shall be entitled to receive grants in accordance with the conditions prescribed in the Regulations for Public Elementary Schools in force for the time being, if such conditions are more advantageous to him than those contained in the said sub-sections.

4.—Article 9 of the said Regulations is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following sub-section :

9.—(b) For the purpose of the appointment and retention of vice principals, assistant teachers and junior assistant mistresses under the Regulations for Public Elementary Schools in force for the time being, the average attendance of pupils to be taken into account shall be the average attendance of pupils other than evacuated children :

Provided that where the conditions in the said Regulations for

(1) the appointment of a teacher ; or

(2) the retention of an existing teacher ; or

(3) the payment of a junior assistant mistress on the appropriate scale of salary prescribed in Article 132 (a) of the said Regulations

would be fulfilled at a receiving school if the attendances made by evacuated children were taken into account, and, in the case of (1), where the Ministry is satisfied that the vacancy which would thus arise cannot or ought not to be filled by the assignment thereto of an assigned teacher, the Ministry may sanction the said appointment, retention or payment (as the case may be) temporarily, on the condition that if the school shall cease to be a receiving school, or if the total average attendance for any quarter shall fail to reach the required retention figure, the recognition of the teacher or the payment of the junior assistant mistress on the appropriate scale of salary shall cease at the end of the succeeding quarter.

5.—These regulations shall be construed with and as forming part of the Public Elementary Schools (Evacuated Children) Regulations, 1940, and shall take and have effect from the date of those Regulations.

REGULATIONS, DATED 18TH FEBRUARY, 1941, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE TEACHERS' SALARIES AND SUPERANNUATION (WAR SERVICE) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1939.

1.—These regulations may be cited as the Public Elementary School (Teachers' War Service) Regulations, 1940, Amending Regulations, No. 1, 1941.
