## SUPPLIES.

### Regulation.

ORDER DATED APRIL 3, 1941, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER THE FEEDING STUFFS (RATIONING) (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER, 1941.

1941. No. 76.

WHEREAS by Article 2 of the Feeding Stuffs (Rationing) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1941 (a), made by the Minister of Food on the 9th day of January, 1941, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, it is provided that a licensed supplier shall not obtain any rationed feeding stuff and no person shall supply any rationed feeding stuff to a licensed supplier except under and in accordance with the terms of a release note, buying permit or other ration document issued by or on behalf of the Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") to the licensed supplier obtaining the rationed feeding stuff :

AND WHEREAS by Article 3 of the said Order it is provided that the quantity of rationed feeding stuff obtained by or supplied to the holder of a ration book issued to him by or on behalf of the Ministry shall not exceed the quantity specified in the instructions on the ration book or other ration document held by the person obtaining the rationed feeding stuff :

AND WHEREAS by Article 12 of the said Order it is provided that the Ministry may from time to time by Order give directions further regulating the obtaining or supply of any rationed feeding stuff :

NOW, THEREFORE, the Ministry, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the said Article 12, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders and directs as follows :—

- 1.—The quantity of feeding stuff which may be supplied to or obtained by the holder of a ration book, release note, buying permit or other ration document shall not exceed one-half of the quantity specified therein.
- 2.—This Order shall come into force on the 7th day of April, 1941.
- 3.—This Order may be cited as the Feeding Stuffs (Regulation of Supplies) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1941.

ORDER, DATED MAY 9, 1941, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE UNDER THE FEEDING STUFFS (RATIONING) (NORTHERN IRELAND) ORDER, 1941.

1941. No. 103.

WHEREAS by Article 12 of the Feeding Stuffs (Rationing) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1941 (a), made by the Minister of Food on the 9th day of January, 1941, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, it is provided that the Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") may from time to time by Order give directions further regulating the obtaining or supply of any rationed feeding stuff :

AND WHEREAS by the Feeding Stuffs (Regulation of Supplies) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1941 (b), the Ministry ordered and directed that the quantity of feeding stuff which might be supplied to or obtained by the holder of a ration book, release note, buying permit or other ration document should not exceed one-half of the quantity specified therein :

NOW, THEREFORE, the Ministry, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by the said Article 12, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby orders and directs as follows :—

1.—The Feeding Stuffs (Regulation of Supplies) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1941 (b), is hereby revoked.

2.—This Order shall come into force on the 12th day of May, 1941.

3.—This Order may be cited as the Feeding Stuffs (Regulation of Supplies) (Northern Ireland) (No. 2) Order, 1941.
