

LABOUR FOR NORTHERN IRELAND, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND, UNDER THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACTS, 1936 TO 1941, AND THE WIDOWS', ORPHANS' AND OLD AGE CONTRIBUTORY PENSIONS ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1936 TO 1941.

The National Health Insurance Joint Committee and the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, acting jointly and in conjunction with the Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred by the National Health Insurance Acts, 1936 to 1941, and the Widows', Orphans' and Old Age Contributory Pensions Acts (Northern Ireland), 1936 to 1941, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby in so far as each is the rule-making authority, and with the approval of the Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland in so far as such approval is necessary, make the following Regulations :—

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the National Health Insurance and Contributory Pensions (Consequential Amendments) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1942, and shall, except where otherwise expressly provided, have effect as from 5th January, 1942.

(2) The Interpretation Act, 1921, applies to the interpretation of these regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.

2.—The provisions of the regulations specified in the first and second columns of the schedule to these regulations shall have effect subject to the amendments set out in the third column to that schedule.

National Health Insurance (Statutory Undertakers Total Exception) Regulations, 1939.	2	In the definition of the Pensions Act, the words “ as amended by any subsequent enactment or any Act repealed by that Act ” shall be inserted after the words “ Widows’, Orphans’ and Old Age Contributory Pensions Act (Northern Ireland), 1936.” The following definition shall be substituted for the definition of the Insurance Act :— “ ‘ the Insurance Act ’ means the National Health Insurance Act, 1936, as amended by any subsequent enactment, or any Act repealed by that Act ;”
