## Medical Benefit Council.

REGULATIONS, DATED 30TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1942, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1936 TO 1941.

1942. No. 185.

The Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the National Health Insurance Acts (Northern Ireland), 1936 to 1941, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:—

- 1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the National Health Insurance (Medical Benefit Council) Amendment Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1942, and shall be read as one with the National Health Insurance (Medical Benefit Council) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1936, as subsequently amended (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations").
- (2) In these regulations the expression "period of the present emergency" has the meaning assigned to it by Section 17 of the National Health Insurance and Contributory Pensions (Emergency Provisions) Act, 1939.
- (3) The Interpretation Act, 1921, applies to the interpretation of these regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.
- 2.—Notwithstanding the provisions of regulation 13 of the principal regulations, the term of office of persons who are members of the Medical Benefit Council at the date of these regulations shall, subject to the provisions of regulation 16 of those regulations, be extended to the 30th day of September first occurring not less than three months after the termination of the period of the present emergency.
