

REGULATIONS, DATED 17TH MARCH, 1942, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE EDUCATION ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1923 TO 1940, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

1942. No. 47.

1.—These regulations may be cited as the Public Elementary Schools Regulations, 1934, Amending Regulations, No. 14, 1942.

2.—The Public Elementary Schools Regulations, 1934 (Statutory Rules and Orders of Northern Ireland, 1934, No. 40), as amended by Statutory Rules and Orders of Northern Ireland, 1935, No. 69 ; 1936, No. 83 ; 1936, No. 159 ; 1937, No. 17 ; 1937, No. 57 ; 1937, No. 87 ; 1938, No. 28 ; 1938, No. 63 ; 1938, No. 125 ; 1939, No. 79 ; 1940, No. 21 ; 1941, No. 73 ; and 1942, No. 43 ; which Regulations as so amended are hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Regulations," are hereby amended as follows :—

3.—Article 3 of the Public Elementary Schools Regulations, 1939, Amending Regulations, No. 12, 1941 (Statutory Rules and Orders, 1941, No. 73) is hereby repealed from 31st March, 1941, and the following Article substituted therefor :—

3.—(1) In addition to the grants payable to teachers under the Principal Regulations, a temporary war bonus shall be payable, as follows :

B. Period from 1st September, 1941, onwards.

Men

Not over £262 10s.	£26	
Over £262 10s. but under £275 10s.	Such rate as, when added to rate of income, will bring total to £288 10s.	
£275 10s. to £525	£13	
Over £525 but under £538	Such rate as, when added to rate of income, will bring total to £538.	

Women

Not over £262 10s.	£19 10s.	
Over £262 10s. but under £271 12s.	Such rate as, when added to rate of income, will bring total to £282.	
£271 12s. to £525	£10 8s.	
Over £525 but under £535 8s.	Such rate as, when added to rate of income, will bring total to £535 8s.	

(2) The bonus shall be payable in respect of recognised service rendered during the periods specified in sub-section (1) of this article, and shall not be reckonable for superannuation purposes.

(3) In this regulation—

- (a) the term "teacher" means a teacher recognised by, and in receipt of a personal salary from, the Ministry. It includes a substitute who is serving in place of a teacher absent on leave on war service, but not a substitute serving in place of a teacher absent for any other cause ;
- (b) the term "income" means the remuneration received by the teacher from the Ministry out of moneys provided by Parliament for duty in a public elementary school, other than fees for evening school instructions, the value of any teacher's residence, and the temporary war bonus for which provision is herein made. Where a teacher is in receipt of compensation awarded by the Civil Service Committee under the Government of Ireland Act, 1920, for his removal from office in consequence of the transfer of the Model School in which he was serving to the local education authority, the said compensation shall be regarded as part of his income.

4.—These regulations shall be construed with and as forming part of the Principal Regulations.
