## GENERAL LICENCE AND DIRECTION, DATED 20TH APRIL, 1942, UNDER THE CONTROL OF FERTILISERS (NORTHERN IRELAND) (NO. 1) ORDER, 1941.

## 1942. No. 55.

The Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland in pursuance of Articles 1, 4 and 5 of The Control of Fertilisers (Northern Ireland) (No. 1) Order, 1941 (a), hereby orders as follows :---

1.—Every licence granted or to be granted for the purpose of the said Articles 1, 4 and 5 shall be deemed to include, in addition to the conditions subject to which it was granted, the following condition, that is to say, a condition that the holder of the licence shall accept delivery and take possession of any fertiliser, tendered to him in fulfilment of any contract made or entered into (whether before or after the coming into force of this Order) with a licensed producer, licensed wholesaler or licensed secondary wholesaler as the case may be, in accordance with the terms of the Control of Fertilisers (Northern Ireland) (No. 1) Order, 1941 (a), or that Order as amended by any subsequent Order, as hereinafter provided :—

- (a) where a licence holder or his servant has been notified by a person, Company or other authority having custody for the time being of such fertilisers that those fertilisers are situate at the place at which the licence holder has agreed—whether before or after the coming into force of this Order—to accept delivery : immediately after the receipt of such notification ; or
- (b) where the fertilisers are conveyed to the licence holder's premises by a road vehicle arriving at such premises during the hours commencing one hour after sunrise and ending one hour before sunset : immediately on the arrival of such vehicle at such premises.

2.—This Order shall come into force on the twenty-third day of April, 1942.
