The National Health Insurance Joint Committee and the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland, acting jointly, by virtue of the powers conferred on them by Section 8 of the National Health Insurance, Contributory Pensions and Workmen's Compensation Act, 1941, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, with the approval of the Ministry of Finance for Northern Ireland, hereby make the following regulations:—

- 1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the National Health Insurance and Contributory Pensions (Temporary Employment in Agriculture) (Emergency Provisions) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1942.
- (2) The Interpretation Act, 1921, applies to the interpretation of these regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.
- 2.—During the operation of these regulations persons employed in pursuance of any scheme for the temporary employment of persons in agriculture (including horticulture and forestry) specified in the Schedule hereto, who, immediately before they became so employed, were not insured or treated as insured under the National Health Insurance Act, 1936, and were not juvenile contributors within the meaning of the National Health Insurance (Juvenile Contributors and Young Persons) Act, 1937, shall not, by virtue of that employment, be treated for the purposes of the National Health Insurance Acts (Northern Ireland), 1936 to 1941, or the Widows', Orphans' and Old Age Contributory Pensions Acts (Northern Ireland), 1936 to 1941, as employed within the meaning of the first mentioned Act.
