Records and Information and Inspection of Premises.

Order, dated 18th September, 1943, made by the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland under Regulation 58A of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939.

1943. No. 106.

The Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") by virtue of the powers conferred on it by Regulation 58A of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, hereby makes the following Order:—

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Undertakings (Records and Short title, Information and Inspection of Premises) (Northern Ireland) Order, commencement and 1943, and shall come into force on the date hereof.
- (2) The Undertakings (Inspection) Order (Northern Ireland), Duties of employers to records
 - 2. Every person carrying on an undertaking shall—

to records, information and

- (a) keep such records relating to the undertaking as the Ministry inspection. may from time to time by notice direct;
- (b) produce to such person or to a person of such class or description as may be designated by or on behalf of the Ministry such records relating to the undertaking and furnish such information relating thereto as may be set out in any notice or direction; and
- (c) permit any person designated by or on behalf of the Ministry to enter and inspect with a view to securing compliance with this Order any premises used for or in connection with the undertaking.
- 3. The provisions of this Order shall be in addition to and not in Saving. derogation of any provisions relating to the keeping or production of records, the furnishing of information or the inspection of premises, contained in any of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, in any Order made under those Regulations or in any direction given under any such Regulation or Order.
