

3.—(1) The provisions of this Order are subject to any directions which may at any time be given by or on behalf of the Ministry and to any licence or authorisation which may be granted by or on behalf of the Ministry under this Order.

(2) Every person holding a licence or authorisation granted under this Order shall comply with every condition imposed by such licence or authorisation.

4. Infringements of this Order are offences against the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939.

5. This Order shall come into force on the Twenty-fourth day of July, 1943, and may be cited as The Ryegrass Seed (Control) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1943.

Ryegrass Seed — General Licence.

GENERAL LICENCE, DATED 1ST SEPTEMBER, 1943, UNDER THE AGRICULTURAL AND VEGETABLES SEEDS ORDER, 1941.

1943. No. 109.

1. Pursuant to Article 2 of the Agricultural and Vegetables Seeds Order, 1941, the Ministry of Agriculture for Northern Ireland (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") authorises until further notice.

- (a) any licensed seedsman to buy from the Ministry Ryegrass Seed harvested in the year Nineteen hundred and forty-three ; and
- (b) any person to sell to the Ministry such Ryegrass Seed of which he is the grower.

2. This licence shall come into force on the 1st day of September, 1943.
