CONTRACTORS' PLANT.

ORDER, DATED 22ND MARCH, 1943, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE UNDER REGULATION 55 OF THE DEFENCE (GENERAL) REGULATIONS, 1939.

1943. No. 37.

The Ministry of Commerce for Northern Ireland by virtue and in exercise of the powers under Regulation 55 of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, delegated to it by the Secretary of State hereby orders as follows :—

1. Save as provided in paragraph 2 hereof no person shall remove from Northern Ireland any item of Contractors' Plant included in the Schedule hereto or any part of such plant except under the authority of a licence granted by the Ministry of Commerce, provided that such licence shall not be withheld in the case of plant brought into Northern Ireland by contractors who had originally obtained such plant outside Northern Ireland for use outside Northern Ireland:

2. Paragraph 1 hereof shall not apply to :—

Contractors' plant owned by Government Departments.

3. This Order may be cited as the Contractors' Plant (Northern Ireland) Order, 1943.

ORDER, DATED 12TH NOVEMBER, 1943, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER REGULATIONS 55 AND 55AA OF THE DEFENCE (GENERAL) REGULATIONS, 1939.

The Ministry of Commerce for Northern Ireland, by virtue and in exercise of the powers under Regulation 55 and 55AA of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, delegated to it by the Secretary of State hereby orders as follows :—

1. Any person who has in his possession or otherwise uses or deals in Contractors' Plant :
 - (a) shall keep, store, move, transport, distribute, dispose, acquire or use such plant in accordance with any Direction given by the Ministry,
