In regulation 2 of the National Health Insurance (Dental Benefit) Amendment Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1942, as amended by the National Health Insurance (Dental Benefit) Amendment Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1943, the words "2nd October, 1943," shall be substituted for the words "3rd July, 1943".

Dental Benefit Amendment Regulations (No. 3)

REGULATIONS, DATED JULY 2, 1943, MADE BY THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE JOINT COMMITTEE AND THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR UNDER THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACT, 1936.

1943 No. 97

The National Health Insurance Joint Committee and the Ministry of Labour, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by the National Health Insurance Act, 1936, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following regulations:—

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the National Health Insurance (Dental Benefit) Amendment Regulations (No. 3) (Northern Ireland), 1943, and shall be read as one with the National Health

Insurance (Dental Benefit) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1939, as subsequently amended (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations").

- (2) The Interpretation Act, 1921, applies to the interpretation of these regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.
- 2. The principal regulations, in their application to any dental letter accepted on or after the 3rd July, 1943, shall be amended as follows:—
 - (1) In proviso (ii) to paragraph (1) of regulation 16, in subparagraphs (2), (3) and (4) of paragraph 5 of the First Schedule and in Part B of the dental letter in the Third Schedule, the words "exclusive of war increase" shall be inserted after all references to the sum of ten shillings.
 - (2) The words "ten shillings plus the war increase for the time being in force appropriate to that sum" shall be substituted for the words "that sum" in proviso (ii) to paragraph (1) of regulation 16.
 - (3) The following table of war increases shall be substituted for that contained in the Second Schedule:—

- "A war increase of 2s. 6d. may be added by a dentist to the examination and report fee specified in item 9 of the Scale of Fees and in Part F of the dental letter."
- (4) Regulation 3 of the National Health Insurance (Dental Benefit) Amendment Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1942, shall cease to have effect.
- 3. The National Health Insurance (Dental Benefit) Amendment Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1942, in their application to dental letters accepted before the 3rd July, 1943, shall be construed as if the definition of "the prescribed period", and all references thereto, were omitted.

REGULATIONS, DATED SEPTEMBER 3RD, 1943, MADE BY THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE JOINT COMMITTEE AND THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR, ACTING JOINTLY, UNDER THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1936 TO 1941.

The National Health Insurance Joint Committee and the Ministry of Labour, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 123 of the National Health Insurance Act, 1936, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following regulations:—

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the National Health Insurance (Deposit Contributors Insurance Section) Amendment Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1943, and shall be read as one with the National Health Insurance (Deposit Contributors Insurance Section) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1939 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal regulations").
- 2. Regulation 4 of the principal regulations shall be amended as follows:—
 - (1) In paragraph (a), the words "two years" shall be substituted for the words "one year".
 - (2) In paragraph (b), the words "three years" shall be substituted for the words "two years".
 - (3) In proviso (i), the words "or, being a woman, the age of sixty, or if she attained the age of sixty before the 1st July, 1940, the 1st July, 1940" shall be added after the words "sixty-five".
