## 1944. No. 2.

Note: By this Order the Ministry of Commerce fixed the rate of payment to the said Ministry for the year 1944 at sevenpence for each million cubic feet of gas sold during the year 1943. The Order, being of temporary effect, has not been printed at length in this Volume.
