## Annual Accounts and Returns.

Order, dated 8th January, 1944, made by the Ministry of Home Affairs under Regulation 56 of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939.

# 1944. No. 4.

The Ministry of Home Affairs in exercise of the powers under Regulation 56 of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, delegated to it by the Delegation of Emergency Powers (Ministry of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland) Order, 1942, made by the Secretary of State under paragraph (1) of Regulation 102A of the said Regulations hereby orders as follows:—

- 1. The provisions of The Railways (Annual Accounts and Returns) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1942, shall extend and apply to accounts and returns for the year 1943.
- 2. This Order may be cited as "The Railways (Annual Accounts and Returns) (Northern Ireland) Order, 1944".

# REINSTATEMENT IN CIVIL EMPLOYMENT.

# Exemption from Restriction.

Order, dated 16th September, 1944, made by the Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland under Regulation 58A of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939.

### 1944. No. 81.

The Ministry of Labour for Northern Ireland by virtue of the powers conferred on it by Regulation 58A of the Defence (General) Regulations, 1939, hereby makes the following Order.

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Reinstatement in Civil Short title, Employment (Exemption from Restriction) (Northern Ireland) Order, commencement and interpretation.
- (2) In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:—
  - "the Act" means the Reinstatement in Civil Employment Act, 1944;
  - "former employer" has the meaning assigned to it in the Act.

#### 2. Where

- (a) Under or by virtue of the provisions of the Act, the former Exclusion of employer of a person to whom the Act applies is under an restrictions on engagement in certain cases.
- (b) the employment into which the person is to be taken is employment in an undertaking or work as to which under one of the Orders set out in the Schedule hereto restrictions on the engagement of workers are imposed;
