

The bonus shall be remitted to the substitute by the Ministry. Where, under the Principal Regulations, the whole amount of the remuneration of the substitute is recoverable from the absent teacher by deduction from salary or otherwise, the whole amount of the bonus shall also be so recoverable, but in all other cases the cost of the bonus shall be borne in full by the Ministry.

5.—These regulations shall be construed with and as forming part of the Principal Regulations.

REGULATIONS, DATED 2ND OCTOBER, 1944, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE EDUCATION ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1923 TO 1942, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

1944. No. 90.

1.—These Regulations may be cited as the Public Elementary Schools Regulations, 1934, Amending Regulations, No. 18, 1944.

2.—The Public Elementary Schools Regulations, 1934 (Statutory Rules and Orders of Northern Ireland, 1934, No. 40), as amended by Statutory Rules and Orders of Northern Ireland, 1935, No. 69; 1936, No. 83; 1936, No. 159; 1937, No. 17; 1937, No. 57; 1937, No. 87; 1938, No. 28; 1938, No. 63; 1938, No. 125; 1939, No. 79; 1940, No. 21; 1941, No. 73; 1942, No. 43; 1942, No. 47; 1942, No. 192; 1943, No. 73; and 1944, No. 12; which regulations, as so amended are hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Regulations", are hereby amended as follows :—

3.—Sub-Section 3 of Article 3 of the Public Elementary Schools Regulations, 1934, Amending Regulations, No. 14, 1942 (Statutory Rules and Orders of Northern Ireland, 1942, No. 47) as amended by Article 8 of the Public Elementary Schools Regulations, 1934, Amending Regulations, No. 15, 1942, (Statutory Rules and Orders of Northern Ireland, 1942, No. 192) is hereby repealed in respect of war bonus payable for service given on and after 1st April, 1944.

4.—These regulations shall be construed with and as forming part of the Principal Regulations.
