Emergency Provisions

REGULATIONS, DATED 28TH DECEMBER, 1945, MADE BY THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE JOINT COMMITTEE AND THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR UNDER SECTION 8 OF THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE, CONTRIBUTORY PENSIONS AND WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION ACT, 1941.

The National Health Insurance Joint Committee and the Ministry of Labour, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 8 of the National Health Insurance, Contributory Pensions and Workmen's Compensation Act, 1941, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and with the approval of the Ministry of Finance, hereby make the following regulations :—

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Contributory Pensions (Emergency Provisions) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1945.

(2) In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires, the expression "the Act" means the Widows', Orphans' and Old Age Contributory Pensions Act (Northern Ireland), 1936, as amended by any subsequent enactment.

(3) The Interpretation Act, 1921, applies to the interpretation of these regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.

2. The actuarial report which, under subsection (1) of section 42 of the Act (which subsection relates to decennial reports on the financial operation of the Act), the Ministry of Finance is required to obtain in the year nineteen hundred and forty-five shall not be obtained.

REGULATIONS, DATED 8TH MARCH, 1945, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF LABOUR IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE UNDER THE WIDOWS', ORPHANS' AND OLD AGE CONTRIBUTORY PENSIONS ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1936 TO 1941.

The Ministry of Labour, in conjunction with the Ministry of Finance, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by the Widows', Orphans' and Old Age Contributory Pensions Acts (Northern Ireland), 1936 to 1941, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following regulations :—

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Contributory Pensions (Isle of Man Reciprocal Arrangements) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1945, and shall be deemed to have had effect as from the 3rd January, 1938, in relation to voluntary contributors, and as from the 10th October, 1939, in relation to all other persons.

(2) Words and expressions in these regulations shall have the same meaning as in the Memorandum of Reciprocal Arrangements set out in the schedule to these regulations.

(3) The Interpretation Act, 1921, applies to the interpretation of these regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of the Parliament of Northern Ireland.
