## THE ELECTORAL REGISTRATION (AMENDING) REGULATIONS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1945, DATED 9TH APRIL, 1945, MADE BY THE MINISTER OF HOME AFFAIRS FOR NORTHERN IRELAND UNDER THE REPRE-SENTATION OF THE PEOPLE ACTS (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1918 TO 1945.

# 1945. No. 39.

In pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Representation of the People Acts (Northern Ireland), 1918 to 1945, I hereby make the following Regulations :—

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Electoral Registration (Amending) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1945, and the Electoral Registration (No. 1) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1945, and the Electoral Registration (No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1945, and these Regulations may be cited together as the Electoral Registration Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1945.

(2) The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply to the interpretation of these Regulations as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

(3) These Regulations shall come into force on the 9th day of April, 1945.

2. The reference in the second column of Part I of the First Schedule to the Electoral Registration (No. 2) Regulations (Northern Ireland), 1945, to the 9th day of April, 1945, as the last day for making claims and objections to Civilian Residence and Business Premises lists, for the making of claims and objections to the Corrupt and Illegal Practices list, and for making application to be entered in the Absent Voters list for the purposes of the May, 1945 (Northern Ireland) Register shall not apply, and the said Schedule shall have effect as if the 14th day of April had been specified therein as the last day for the making of the claims, objections or applications aforesaid.
