

allowance or scale salary shall be payable as from 1st April following the two-yearly period in which the average number of pupils on the rolls of the school so changed, and shall continue to be payable until the 31st March following the end of a two-yearly period ending 31st December in each of which years the average number of pupils on the rolls of the school again so changes that a further change in the rate of salary or allowance is required to be made in accordance with the provisions of these Regulations."

**Public Elementary School (Teachers' War Service) Regulations,
Amending Regulations, No. 6.**

REGULATIONS, DATED 17TH JULY, 1946, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION UNDER THE TEACHERS' SALARIES AND SUPERANNUATION (WAR SERVICE) ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1939, AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE.

The Ministry of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Ministry") in pursuance of the powers vested in it by Section 6 of the Teachers' Salaries and Superannuation (War Service) Act (Northern Ireland), 1939, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, and after consultation with the Ministry of Finance, hereby makes the following Regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Elementary School (Teachers' War Service) Regulations, 1940, Amending Regulations, No. 6, 1946.

2. The Public Elementary School (Teachers' War Service) Regulations, 1940, as amended by subsequent Regulations, shall have effect subject to the following provisions of these Regulations.

3. For Sub-section (3) of Section (c) of Article 4 of the said Regulations there shall be substituted the following sub-section :—

"(3) Where the absent teacher is a principal, the teacher who discharges the duties of principal during such absence shall be eligible to receive—

- (i) if an assistant or if the substitute for the absent principal—
Principal's Allowance at the rate payable to a principal
teacher of the school.
- (ii) if a vice-principal or a privileged assistant or a holder of
the second post of special responsibility—the allowance
at the rate payable under the last preceding paragraph or
the allowance at the rate to which he is entitled as vice-
principal or as privileged assistant or as holder of the
second post of special responsibility whichever is the
greater."

4. These Regulations shall be construed as one with the Public Elementary School (Teachers' War Service) Regulations, 1940, and shall have effect as from 1st April, 1945.

Regulations for the Secondary School Certificate Examinations, Amending Regulations, No. 6.

REGULATIONS, DATED THE 20TH NOVEMBER, 1946, MADE BY THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION FOR NORTHERN IRELAND, UNDER SECTION 99 OF THE EDUCATION ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1923, AND LAID BEFORE PARLIAMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THAT SECTION.

1. These Regulations may be cited as "The Secondary School Examinations Regulations, Amending Regulations, No. 6, 1946".

2. The Secondary School Examinations Regulations, 1935 (Statutory Rules and Orders of Northern Ireland, 1935, No. 45) as amended by subsequent Regulations, are hereinafter referred to as The Principal Regulations.

3. The Principal Regulations shall have effect subject to the following provisions of these Regulations.

4. For Regulation 25 of the Principal Regulations, there shall be substituted the following Regulation :—

"25. (1) To qualify for the award of the Senior Certificate a candidate must obtain at least 40 per cent. of the sum of the
